



Most SMBs expect that spending for financial management software and outsourced financial management services will remain flat. However, SMBs are more likely to forecast spending increases for software than for services.















time, increase efficiencies, be more prepared at tax time, and provide the intelligence needed to make better

As businesses grow and become more complex, so do their needs and requirements for financial management

- software. However, these solutions tend to be very sticky: Companies tend to stick with a tried-and-true method to manage these functions until that method can no longer meet critical requirements. As a result, SMBs sometimes wait too long to switch to new solutions. Businesses that are experiencing
 - growth, changing business models, merging with or acquiring other companies, or simply spending too much time and energy managing their finances are likely to gain significant advantages by adding new functionality to existing solutions, or moving up from a solution they have outgrown.
